Last year we had an amazing display of artwork from 27 schools exhibiting in the Education Tent - we very much appreciate the time and effort involved. With 18,000 visitors to the Show, this is a brilliant opportunity to showcase your school.

Would you like to exhibit in the Celebration of Education Tent this year at our 109<sup>th</sup> Show. Your exhibit can be based around the theme or it can be something you have been working on during the school year – it's up to you! Each school is allocated a 3.6m wide by 1.8m deep stand with a back and sides, plus 2 trestle tables.

Most schools set up their stands after a busy day at school so the tent is open all day and up until 8pm on the Friday evening to give you as much time as possible. The stand needs to be taken down by 7pm latest on show day please.

Prizes are presented for best Nursery/Pre-school, Primary and Secondary school exhibits and judging will not take the theme into account so please don't worry if your display is not theme based.

The theme this year is "Our Communities – Our Show". Our communities are more than the place where we live, it's also the clubs and groups we belong to that bring us together. Our Show is where we celebrate these communities in the countryside, education, family, livestock and sports areas on show day.

### **Competitions**

We will be running 3 schools' competitions again this year and there will be prizes! You don't have to have a stand to enter the competitions. Exhibits need to be displayed in the designated area for competition entries and not on your stand.

- Planted decorated pair of wellies
- A scarecrow made from re-cycled materials
- A string of bunting, incorporating the theme "Our Communities – Our Show"

Exhibits need to be brought to the Education Tent for display on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> July (before 8pm) or Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> by 9am, with judging commencing promptly at 9am.

Every parent in your school is able to claim a free online child ticket with a code which will be emailed when you have applied for a stand. We will also send three complimentary tickets for teachers in June.
